Greetings from organising committee of Geniuslane 2017 !!!

We are delighted to invite you to Lucknow on 12th November 2017. We have been working to develop an advanced intervention program to deal with the menace of Neurodisability in Uttar Pradesh. We have the following goals.

- 1) To set up Paediatrician led child development centre in all cities of Uttar Pradesh.
- 2) To provide a Transparent, Evidence Based services for children nearer to their home.
- 3) Accountable service where we can predict prognosis for the child based on data of previous work done



- 4) Robust protocol to ensure a normal life with main stream school integration where possible.
- 5) Affordable service with help for poor children
- 6) Professional development and updates of Pediatricians
- 7) Training and development of therapist. In our pilot project we trained people with no prior experience and after training all of them were able to do the job with high standards.
- 8) Manufacture and development of equipment used in interventions.

The work was designed by Dr Rahul Bharat from UK and is completing phase 2 in three years and have about 700 children who have received treatment.

This CME is an opportunity to know more about our work and our phase 3 which will help develop child development centre in other cities of Uttar Pradesh.

The following are the highlights of the CME

- 1) Practical short history to identify children with Neurodisability
- 2) Small group workshops with at least 10 children examined by candidate
- 3) Candidate pack containing protocol and guidance to be used in their clinic
- 4) Written and most upto date information provided to Doctors who register early
- 5) Practical workshop to look at abnormal EEG and MRI brain in Epileptic Encephalopathy and Encephalitis respectively.
- 6) Team building, networking and International updating of Neurology/ Neuro disability to transform services in your city.
